Our primary purpose is to provide netball to the South Canberra Community.

Playing Netball

Our goal is to allow our players to be the best they can by allowing them to improve their netball skills by through good coaching and competitive netball thus ensure quality players for our representative teams. To do this, we will be:

- Investing in the expansion of our winter competition, with addition of new teams from schools and the community;
- Expanding the reach of the Rep Readiness programs to develop our players' skill base;
- Improving the quality and depth of our representative programs;
- Fostering a program to ensure that all coaches receive some training each year;
- Expanding the umpires development program to ensure that all umpires receive training every year;
- Fostering a program to badge our umpires so that by 2018-19 seasons, and beyond, all senior games are umpired by badged umpires;

People and Community Support

Our goal is to engage with the SCNA, and the wider community, to attract personal and financial support for our operations through:

- The appointment of a Volunteers' Coordinator to ensure that they receive the support required to operate and feel well rewarded;
- Working with the SCNA and wider communities to attract financial and other support for our successful operations;
- Participating in the National Netball Foundation program (http://netball.com.au/netball-foundation/);
- Commit to holding a charity event throughout the year;
- Engage with non-netball community groups within the South Canberra region with a view to collaborating and building relationships over shared issues such as sport administration;
- Provide ongoing support and training to SCNA clubs in the use of the MyNetball platform;
- Recognise the work of long term SCNA supporters through life membership.

Governance and Financial Management

Our goal is to retain the financial strength and independence of SCNA through:

- Continuing a high level of control expenditure;
- Developing a budget program for one to five years;
- Being recognised as a leader in corporate governance and financial management;

- Updating the constitution to reflect the needs of the association;
- Providing thorough induction of new Executive members to ensure smooth transition to the role;
- Providing Executive members with appropriate training allow they to best fulfil the needs to their role.

Facilities and Infrastructure

Our goal is to provide the best facilities and infrastructure to support our players, coaches, umpires and administrators to achieve their best in netball, through:

- Continuing to invest in our courts and their surrounds to ensure that players, coaches, umpires and spectators have a safe and pleasant environment to enjoy their netball;
- The development and implementation of a master plan to:
 - upgrade the current pavilion to provide quality office space, meeting room/s and training facilitates; and
 - upgrade the court surrounds, including the BBQ pavilion, landscaping at the north end of the courts;
- Creating an information infrastructure that facilitates information sharing at all levels of the organisation.
